

***** IMPORTANT NOTICE TO PET OWNERS *****

THE UNIVERSAL CITY DOG PARK IS CLOSED UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE:

THE UNIVERSAL CITY ANIMAL HOSPITAL HAS CONFIRMED SEVERAL CASES OF CANINE INFLUENZA AND KENNEL COUGH. THIS WAS REPORTED EVEN IN DOGS THAT HAVE BEEN VACCINATED AGAINST KENNEL COUGH AND CANINE INFLUENZA.

BOTH CANINE INFLUENZA AND KENNEL COUGH ARE EXTREMELY CONTAGIOUS. INFECTED DOGS CAN SPREAD THE DISEASE BY COUGHING, SNEEZING, AND BARKING.

CANINE INFLUENZA CAN BE SPREAD BY DIRECT CONTACT THROUGH WATER AND FOOD BOWLS AND PLAYING WITH THE SAME TOYS. THE VIRUS CAN LIVE UP TO 12 HOURS ON CLOTHING AND 48 HOURS ON SURFACES.
